

Youth Takeover Week 2025: Final Report

Hosted by Natrona Collective Health Trust | July 28 – August 2, 2025

Overview:

Youth Takeover Week brought together 21 teens from across Natrona County to design, lead, and implement a youth-centered grantmaking process. Over five days, youth learned about nonprofits and philanthropy, developed funding criteria, created and distributed a peer survey, conducted live interviews with applicants, and ultimately made funding decisions to support third spaces- neutral, accessible, and inclusive places outside of home or school. Their work culminated in the awarding of \$200,000 into the community to support third spaces for teens.

Who Participated

- **21 teens** ages 13–18
- **Average age:** 15
- **Gender breakdown:** 11 female, 10 male
- **Demographics:**
 - 52% low income
 - 38% nonwhite
 - Representing schools across the county:
 - Casper Christian School
 - Cowboy State Virtual Academy

 - Recent high school graduates

What They Did:

- **Explored third space concepts*** through personal reflection, mapping exercises, creative design, and group dialogue.
- **Identified real barriers** teens face accessing safe and meaningful third spaces: money, transportation, unwelcoming policies, lack of variety, and fear of being kicked out.

- **Mapped current hangout spots** (e.g., parking lots, David Street Station, Walmart, gyms) and compared them to where they *wish* they could go (e.g., Boondocks, Wingstop, laser tag, niche shops).
- **Defined what makes a third space "awesome"**- Atmosphere (safe, warm, welcome, relaxing), accessibility (open to all people and designed for all abilities, welcoming & hours of operation), communal spaces (recreation, kitchen, lounge), and entertainment (music, gaming, pool tables, tournaments, speakers, physical activity). Although not a part of the defined criteria, youth also expressed a preference for neutral spaces that are free of expectations and allow them to create the experience they want in the space.
- **Developed and distributed a survey** and collected over 200 responses in less than 48 hours. Integrated feedback into grantmaking decisions.
- **Designed a youth-friendly grant scoring rubric** focused on their criteria of what makes third spaces awesome. Planning grants were scored in the areas of atmosphere, entertainment, accessibility, communal spaces, and being neutral.
- **Interviewed 12 nonprofit applicants** and asked questions about their projects.
- **Voted to award planning grants** to top proposals that best aligned with rubric scores and teen-defined third space criteria.
- **Planned next steps for follow-up**, including reviewing how funds are used and learning about project outcomes in the future.

What Teens Told Us (Survey Highlights | 200+ Responses) *

Demographics & Access:

- Majority of respondents were ages 13–16
- Most hang out in **East, West, and Downtown Casper**
- **Top transportation methods:**
 - 42% rely on parents
 - 43% drive their own car
 - Very few use public transit

Current Use of Third Spaces:

- Only **24%** visited a youth-designed hangout space in the past week

- **20%** had never been to one at all

Barriers to Access:

- **Cost and transportation** were the most frequently cited barriers
- Many youth are “hanging out” in parking lots or big box stores due to a lack of welcoming, affordable alternatives

Top Priorities for a Hangout Space:

- **Atmosphere:** Relaxed, warm, safe
- **Entertainment:** Games, music, activities
- **Communal vibe:** Space to meet or be around others doing their own thing
- **Accessibility:** Inclusive, neutral, and flexible hours

Most Requested Activities:

- Lounging and relaxing (79%)
- Board/video games (72%)
- Creative activities (62%)
- Sports and physical games (52%)
- Recreation (foosball, billiards, etc.) (42%)

Grantmaking Outcomes

Planning Grant Award

- **Recipient:** *Casper Recreation Center*
- **Purpose:** To explore development of new youth-centered third space activities and improvements

Participatory Grantmaking: \$150,000 Awarded

Youth participants selected four organizations to receive funding for sustaining or enhancing existing third spaces:

1. **Natrona County Public Library** – Free, welcoming environment with built-in access to learning, gathering, and relaxation
2. **David Street Station** – Outdoor events and social connection space for teens and families
3. **Mercer Family Resource Center** – Supportive programming and space for wellness and skill-building
4. **The Void Outreach** – Peer-led, kill-focused environment for career building and belonging

What We Learned

Teens are natural systems-thinkers.

They didn't just focus on fun activities- they also asked critical questions about equity, access, sustainability, and peer representation.

Youth face systemic barriers to third spaces.

Many youth hang out in parking lots or cruise around town simply because those are the only spaces they don't get kicked out of. They crave *variety*, *safety*, and *belonging*- not just physical spaces, but emotional ones.

“I want to be around others doing my own thing.”

“At home I have control. I want that elsewhere too.”

Accessibility is multifaceted.

Youth defined it as more than just affordability - it's about having a space they can physically get to, where they feel like they belong, and where there's no judgment or gatekeeping.

Social media is a partial substitute for third space.

Teens acknowledged its role in helping them stay connected but emphasized that it lacks depth, intimacy, and emotional safety.

“Social media increases access but decreases quality.”

Youth want power with adult support - not control.

They recognized the importance of adult involvement in making spaces safe, but were clear that teens must be the decision-makers when it comes to design and purpose.

“A third space needs adults to support, but not govern.”

“Peers need power. Adults should help push us to lead.”

- Teens are highly capable decision-makers when given power and structure.
- They want spaces that allow **freedom without oversight, belonging without judgment, and engagement without cost.**
- Accessibility isn't just physical - it's emotional, social, and financial.
- Teens are eager to co-create solutions and continue being part of change.

“We need more places to be ourselves around others, not just be alone at home.”

Impact

By the end of Youth Takeover Week, young people had:

- Made \$200,000 in funding recommendations.
- Articulated a shared vision for inclusive third spaces in Natrona County.
- Learned key skills in evaluation, facilitation, interviewing, and decision-making.
- Built confidence in their power to shape community change.

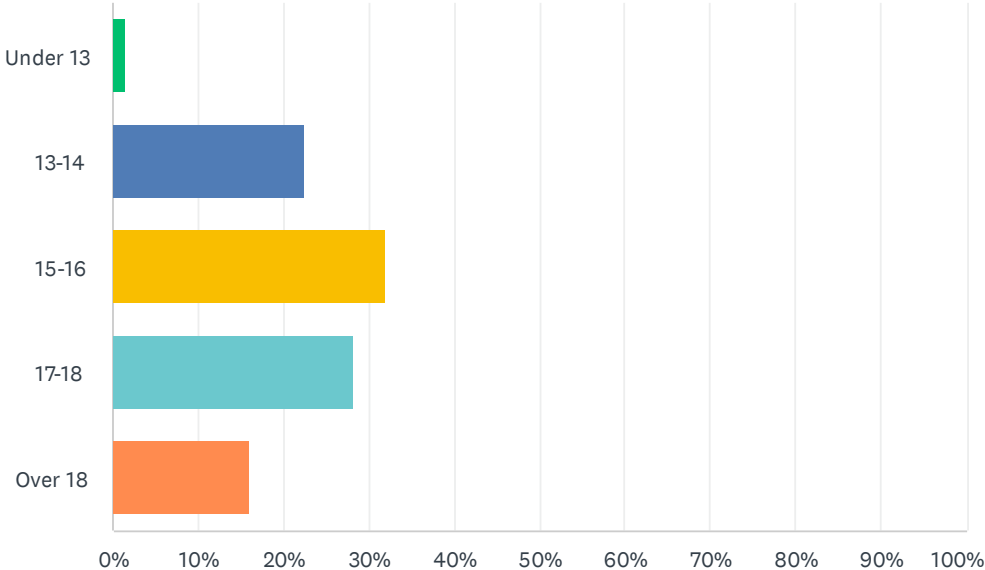

Q1 How old are you?

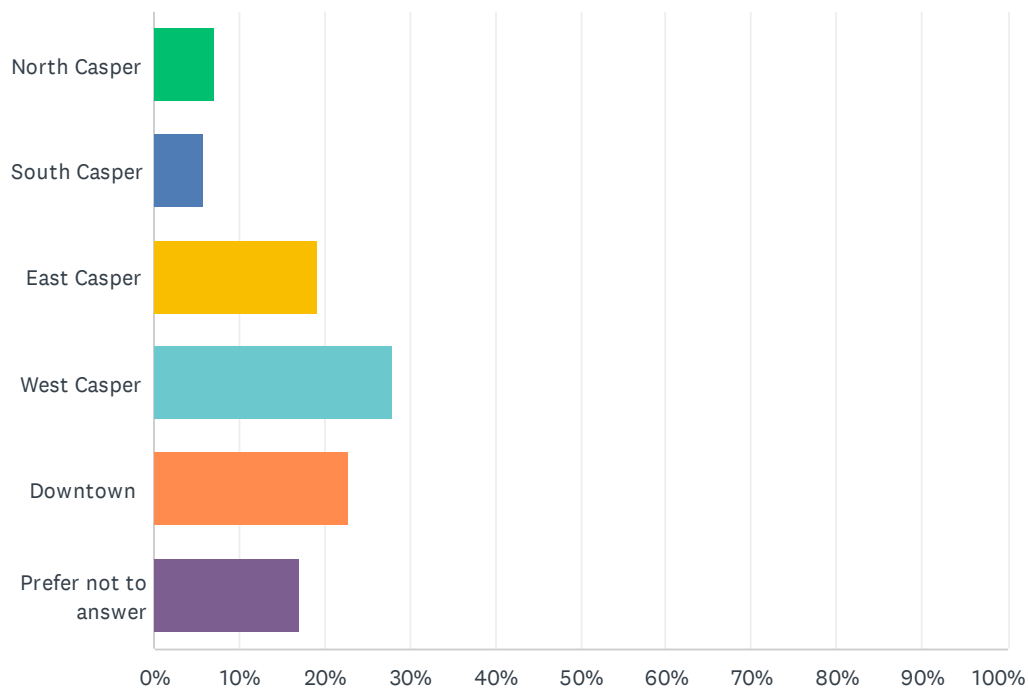

Q2 Where do you spend the most time?

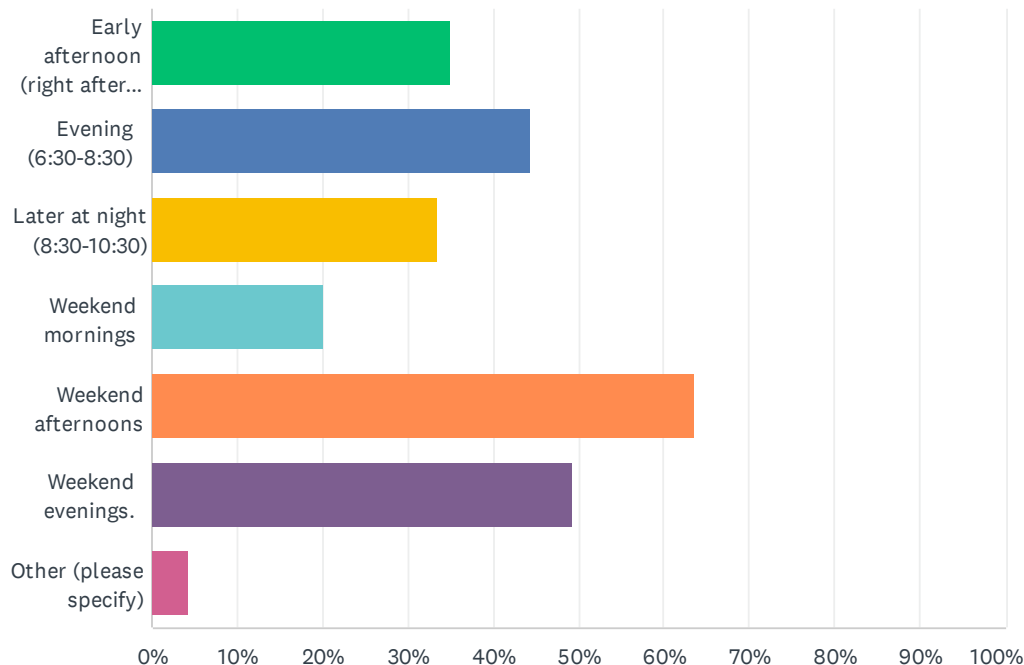

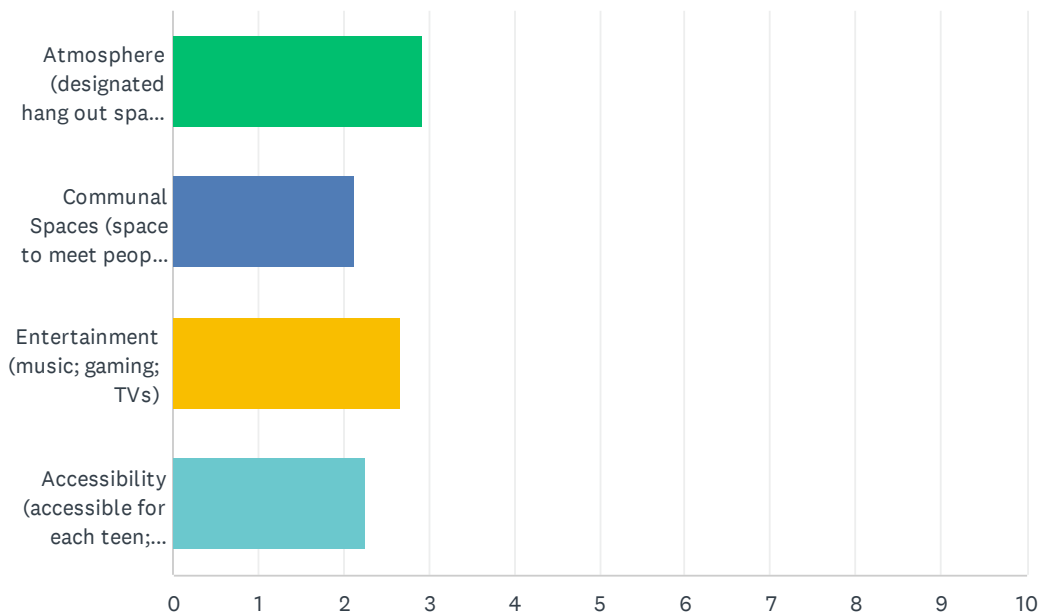

Q4 When you think about a hang out space (somewhere other than school or home), rank the following in order of importance:

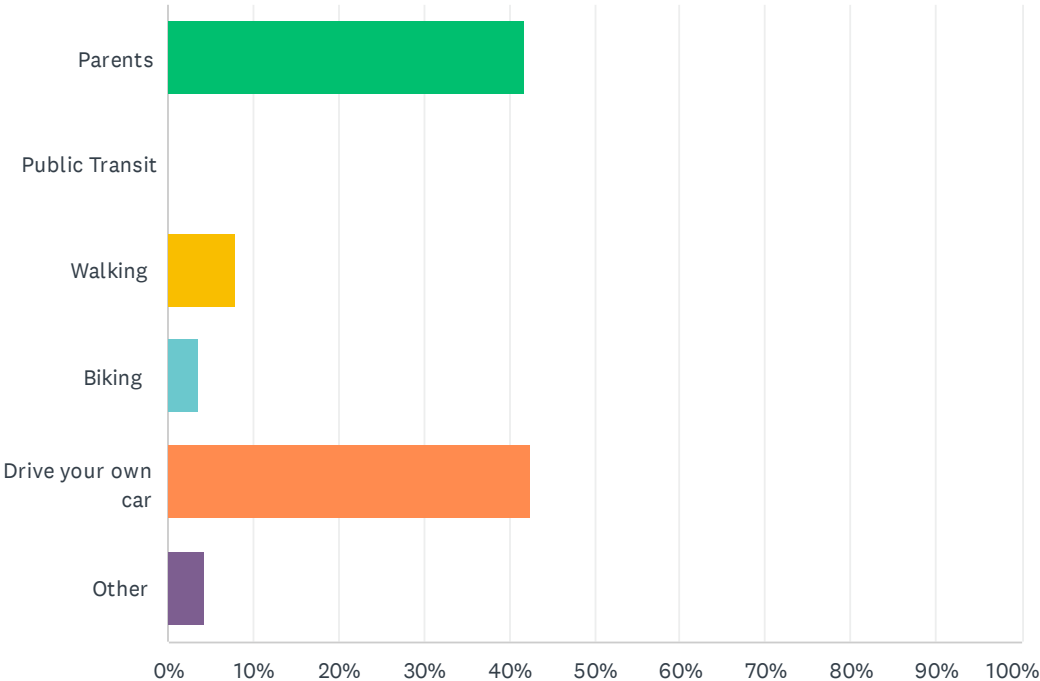

Q5 Which mode of transportation do you use most?

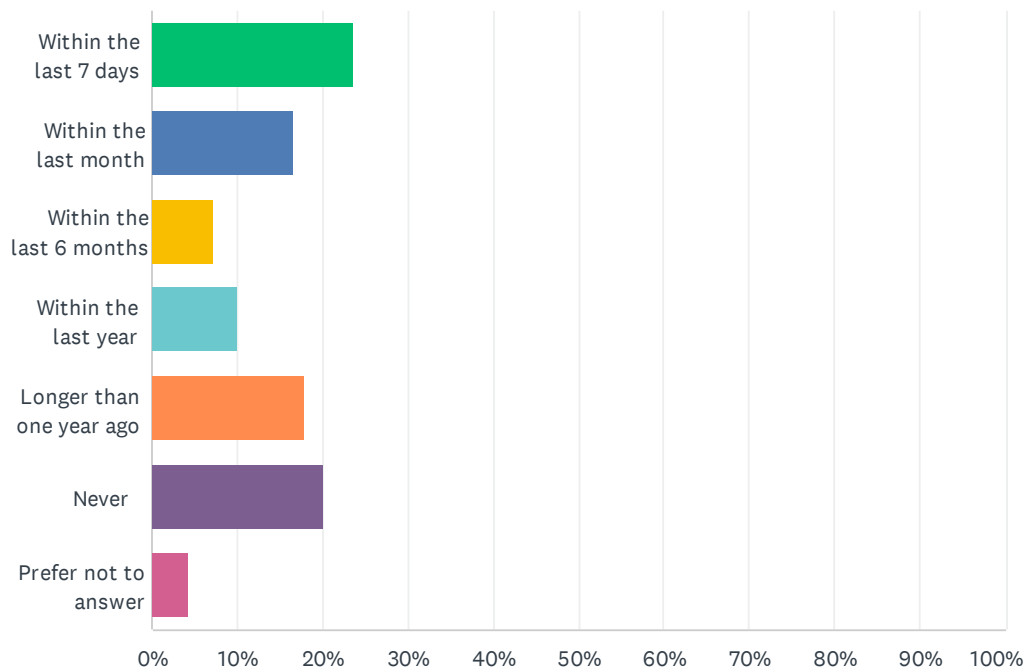

Q6 When was the last time you hung out somewhere designed for teens (other than school)?

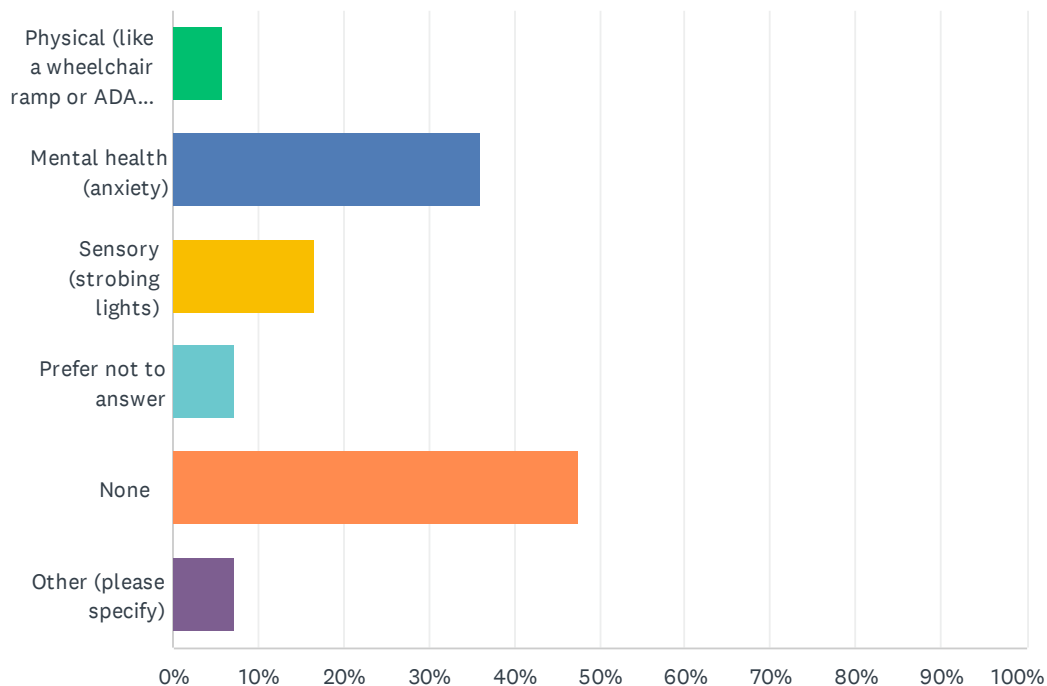

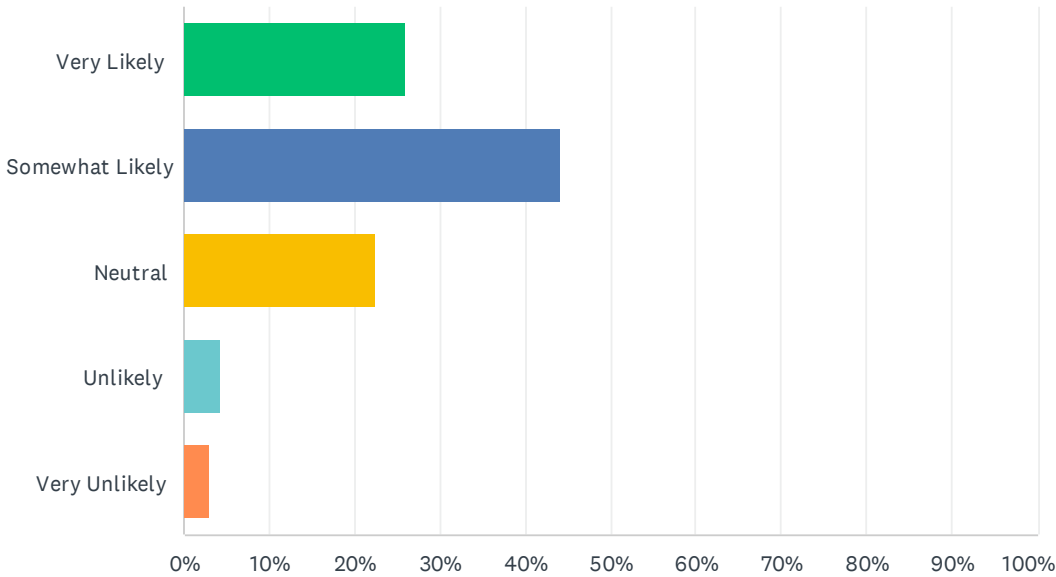

Q8 If a hang out space designed for teens existed in Casper, how likely would you be to use it?

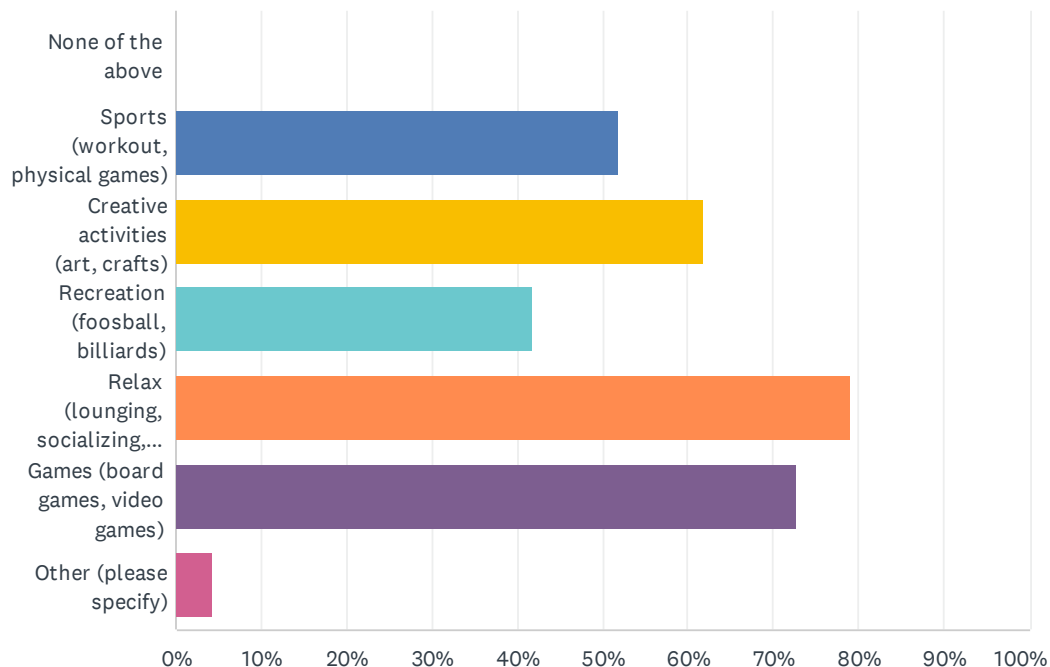
