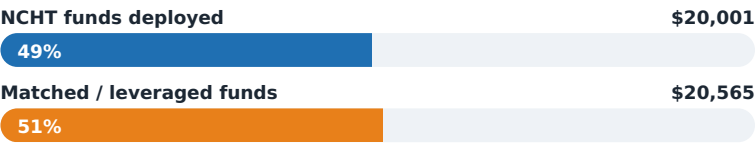

With a **\$20,000** commitment from the Natrona Collective Health Trust, CAPNC deployed **\$20,001** in direct NCHT utility assistance and braided it with an additional **\$20,565** in matching federal and local funds — turning one grant into **\$40,566** of bills paid on behalf of **64 households** and **149 individuals**. Every NCHT dollar was more than matched, more than doubling the Trust’s reach.

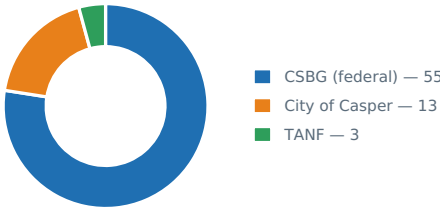
THE LEVERAGE STORY — ONE DOLLAR BECAME MORE THAN TWOWHERE THE MATCH CAME FROM

TOTAL UTILITY BILLS PAID FOR THE COMMUNITY

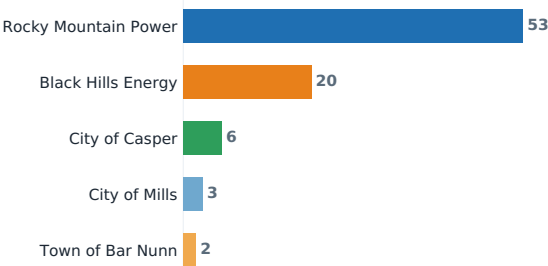
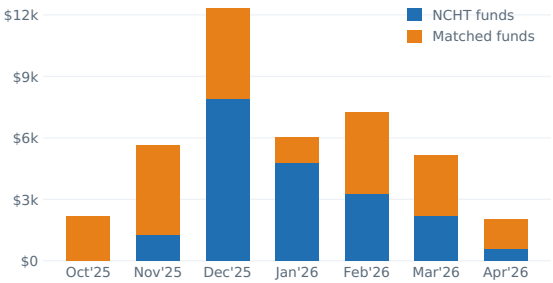
